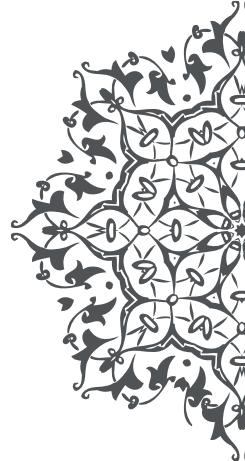
Our Vision

A quality education is the very foundation of change.

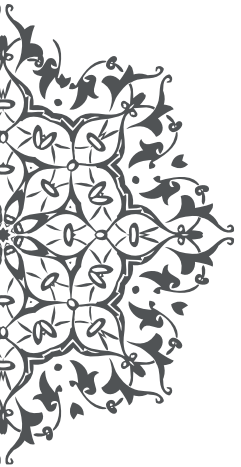

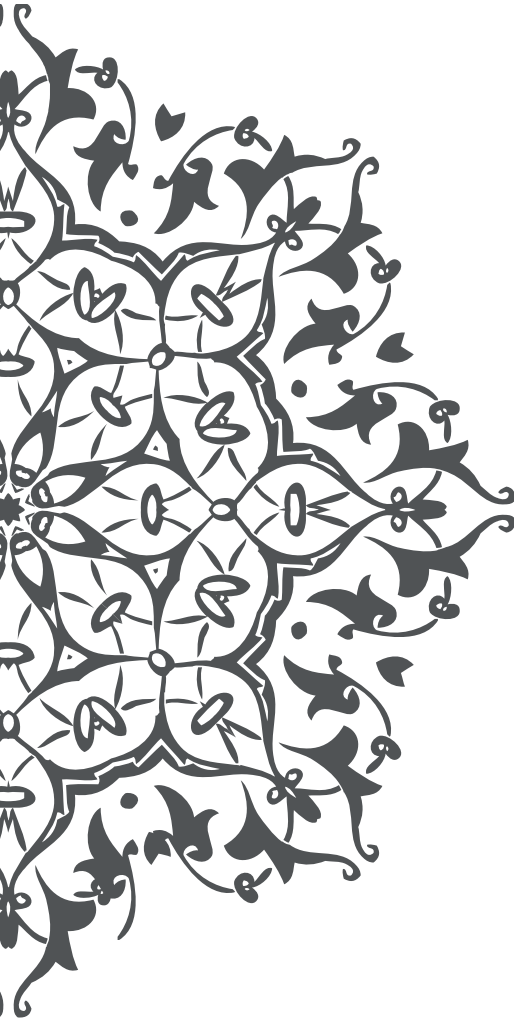


Our Mission

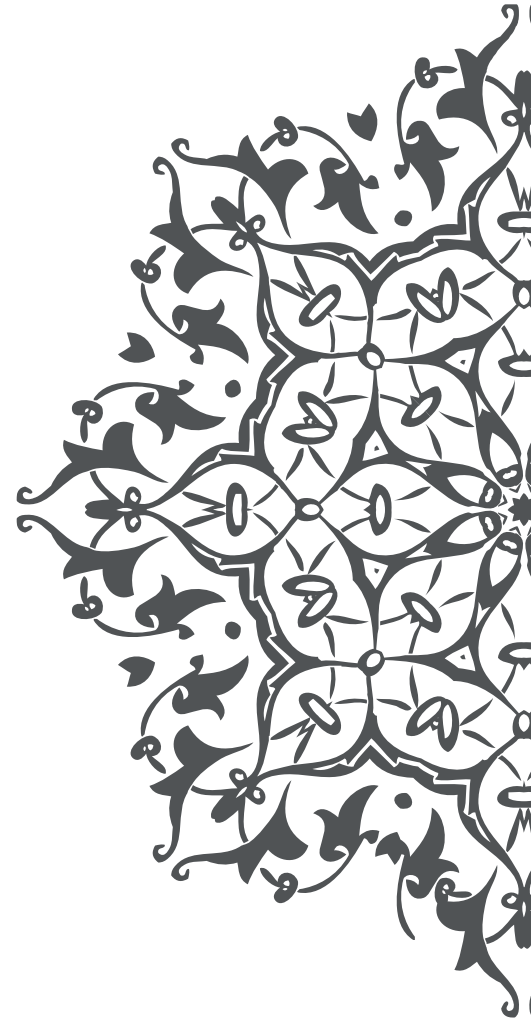

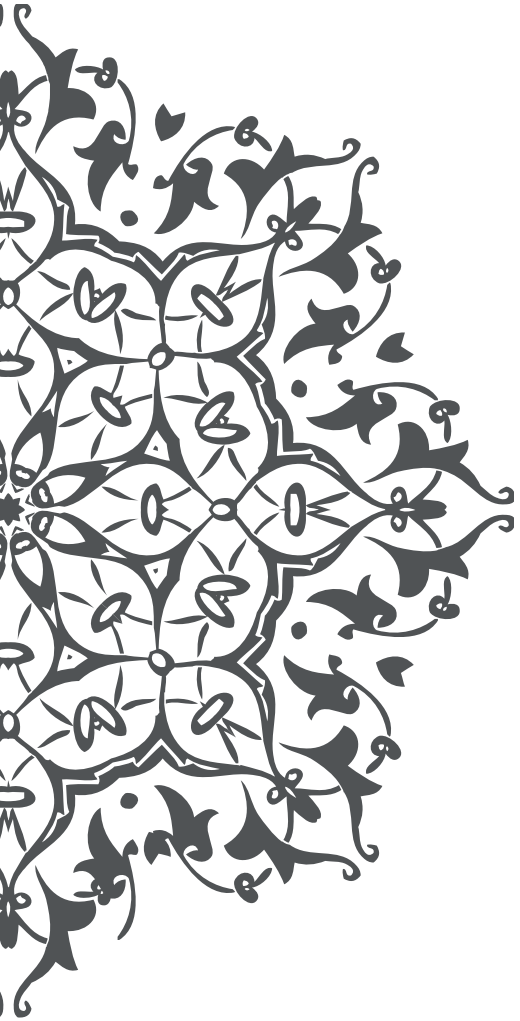




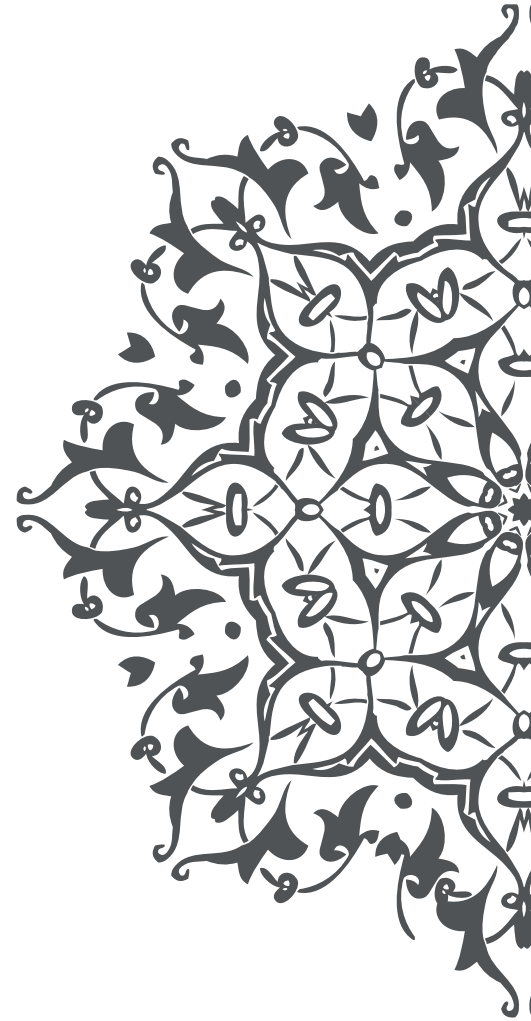

Balika Sadan

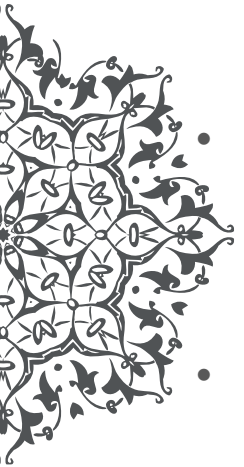
- Due to to extremely heavy rain during the monsoon season damage has occurred at the Balika Sadan School building mainly roof and toilets

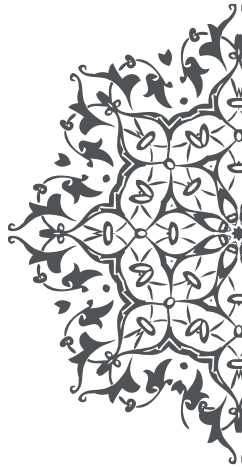
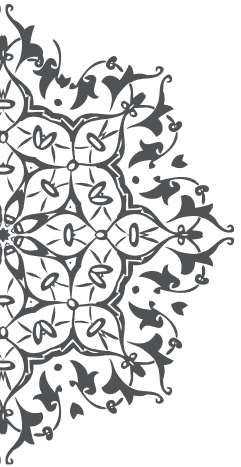

Our aim for the next 4 years:

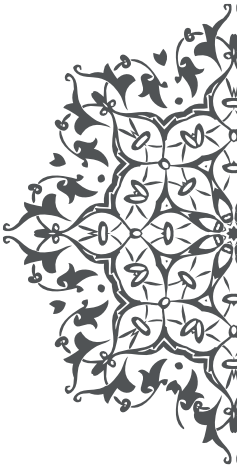
Increase funding from €20.000,00 per year to €60.000,00 per year for 5 years.

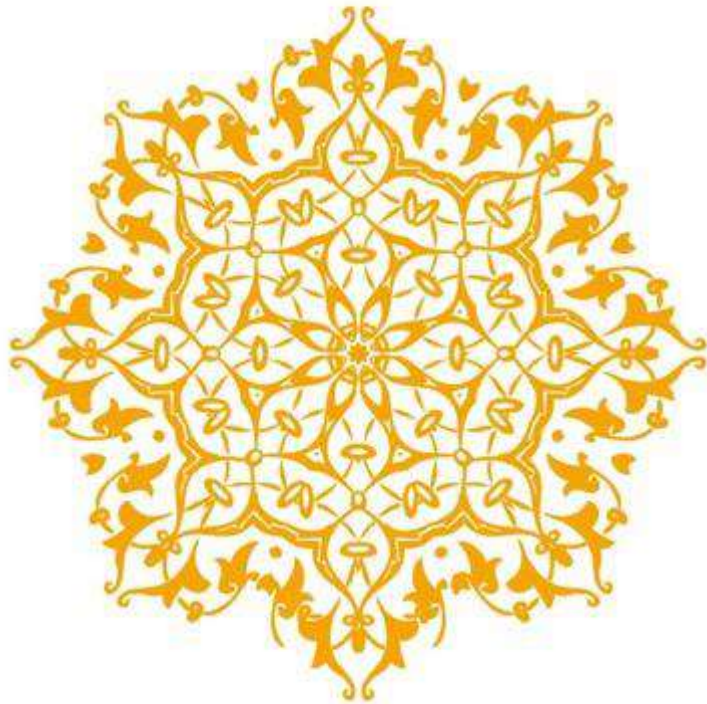
By committing 4 more Founders, donating €10.000,00 per year for 5 years
